Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement Southern California Youth Bull Riders Association

This will be effective from date of signature and must be renewed when member changes divisions.

We, the undersigned, hereby request that the below named minor or minors be granted permission to enter the restricted areas, to participate as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in rodeo events, to compete for money, prizes, recognition or reward, to be covered by participants hospitalization insurance, if applicable, as limited by the master policy (all collectively hereinafter called permissive entry.)

In consideration of permissive entry to minor into the restricted area, which is the area from which admission to the general public is restricted, which includes, but is not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens adjacent walkways, concessions, and other appurtenances, we the undersigned, on behalf of the minor and for ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, spouses and assigns, do hereby:

1. RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the rodeo committee, stock contractor, rodeo association, sponsors, area operators or owners, as each of them, their officers, agents and employees (all hereinafter collectively referred to as, release) from any and all claims and liability arising out of strict liability or ordinary negligence of releases or any other participant which caused the undersigned injury
death, damages or property damage. We, the undersigned, jointly, severally and in common, covenant to hold releases harmless and to indemnity releases from any claim, judgment or expenses (release may incur arising out of any of the minor's activities or presence in the restricted area.)

2. Understand that minor's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in rodeo events contains Danger and Risk of Injury or Death to Minor, that conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable, and that there is Inherent Danger in rodeo which we each appreciate and voluntarily assume because the minor and we choose to do so. Each of the undersigned has observed events of the type that the minor seeks to participate in. We further understand that the arena surface, access ways or lack thereof, lighting or lack thereof, and weather conditions all change and pose a danger to the minor or minors. We further understand that other contestants and participants pose a danger to the minor or Minors, but nevertheless, WE EACH VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ACCEPT ALL RISKS CONNECTED WITH THE MINOR'S ENTRY INTO THE RESTRICTED AREA AND/OR PARTICIPATION IN ANY BULL RIDING/ RODEO EVENT.

Agree that this agreement shall apply to any incident, injury, accident or death occurring on the above date and for a period of (1) year thereafter or until the minor or minor's association membership expires, whichever shall last occur. All subsequent agreement and release documents signed by any of the undersigned shall amply', but shall in no way limit the provision of the document, The provisions of this document may be cancelled by any one of the undersigned by delivering to the above association written cancellation of this agreement which shall be effective 24 hours after the date said cancellation is actually received by the bull riding association.

Releasers, parents or guardians of the undersigned minor or minors agree to indemnities, the releases and each of them from any loss, liability damage or costs they may incur due to the presence or participation of the minor or minors in the described activities whether caused by the negligence of the Releases or otherwise.

Including without limitation, Member, Contestants, Parents, Observer, Helpers, Volunteer, Stock Contractor(s), Junior & Jackie Saenz, Committees and contract personnel agree to discharge, waive, and release and covenant not to sue Southern California Youth Bull Riders, Inc. Furthermore, where permitted by applicable law, this discharge waiver and release also includes claims, demands and liabilities arising out of gross negligence or willful or wanton negligence of the parties so released. This discharge also includes claims, demands and liabilities for indemnities and contributions arising from property damage, personal injury and/or death to a third party. Before each SCYBR event and before Member competes, the Member and Member's Parents each will inspect the arena, chutes, ground, pens, livestock, cowboy protectors, arena personnel, gate pullers, medical personnel, and restricted areas to determine the safety, condition and qualifications of each and will hereby either warrant each safe and qualified for safe operation in the production of an event or should any of the undersigned find that any condition of the event production unsafe, the Member may either not compete and withdrawal from the event, or provide at Member's (or Member's Parents) own cost and risk their own cowboy protectors, medical personnel or gate pullers, as long as each has signed all release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity forms required by the SCYBR.
